

How to Register for the Nurse Assistant Certification Exam

If you are enrolled in a CNA training program or equivalency program and wish to take the NATAP test upon completing the required hours, please follow the steps below:

1. Complete a nurse assistant certification exam registration application

2. Testing Fees –

Testing Fees:

Both Manual and Written Test -----	\$90
Manual Skills Only -----	\$55
Written Test Only -----	\$35
Oral Written Test (additional fee) -----	\$15

No personal checks or cash will be accepted

3. Send your completed registration application and testing fees:

- Applications must be received **10 business days prior** to the examination.
- You will be added to the test site roster based upon a complete and accurate application.
- **You may not test if your name is not on the roster.**
- You will be mailed a card confirming your registration.

Key Points

- If you plan to test with your class as a group, your instructor will give you the specific information you need to complete the registration form.
- If you are testing as an individual, or scheduling a retest, please call the regional office (714) 895-8708 and we will assist you in selecting a date and test site. Dates also available at www.regionaltestingcenter.org
- If you are an instructor and wish to schedule an exam for your students, please contact the testing coordinator in your area.
- If your equivalency was approved by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), you will be assigned an approval/sponsor code. You will be instructed to enter this number as your approval/sponsor code. Approval date will be date CDPH signed your application. Please note if you are renewing your certificate, your approval date will be two years after your expiration date. CDPH will indicate your expiration date on the top of your 283c renewal application.
